



Why did ServeINC produce Fiddler on the Roof?

ServeINC is a group of churches in the Albany area who have banded together since 2008 to promote the gospel of Jesus Christ in the Albany area. Our first initiative, Willamette Celebration was conducted at Timber Linn Park as a festival in 2010. It was the largest event of its type up to that time. It featured a variety of community service activities, Christian musical artists, athletic demonstrations and evangelist Mike Silva.

Since that time **ServeINC** has worked together to unite churches together in community service. Most notably, **ServeINC** has painted a number of Greater Albany Public Schools and Jefferson Schools, as well as other acts of community service each year. **ServeINC** member churches desire to elevate the name of Jesus Christ in the Albany community through these acts of service, as well as community prayer events and worship.

Fiddler on the Roof is our second family event that is promoted to demonstrate the unity of the churches in the Albany area. In a world where there is so much division, we choose to set aside our differences and celebrate together those things that unite us.

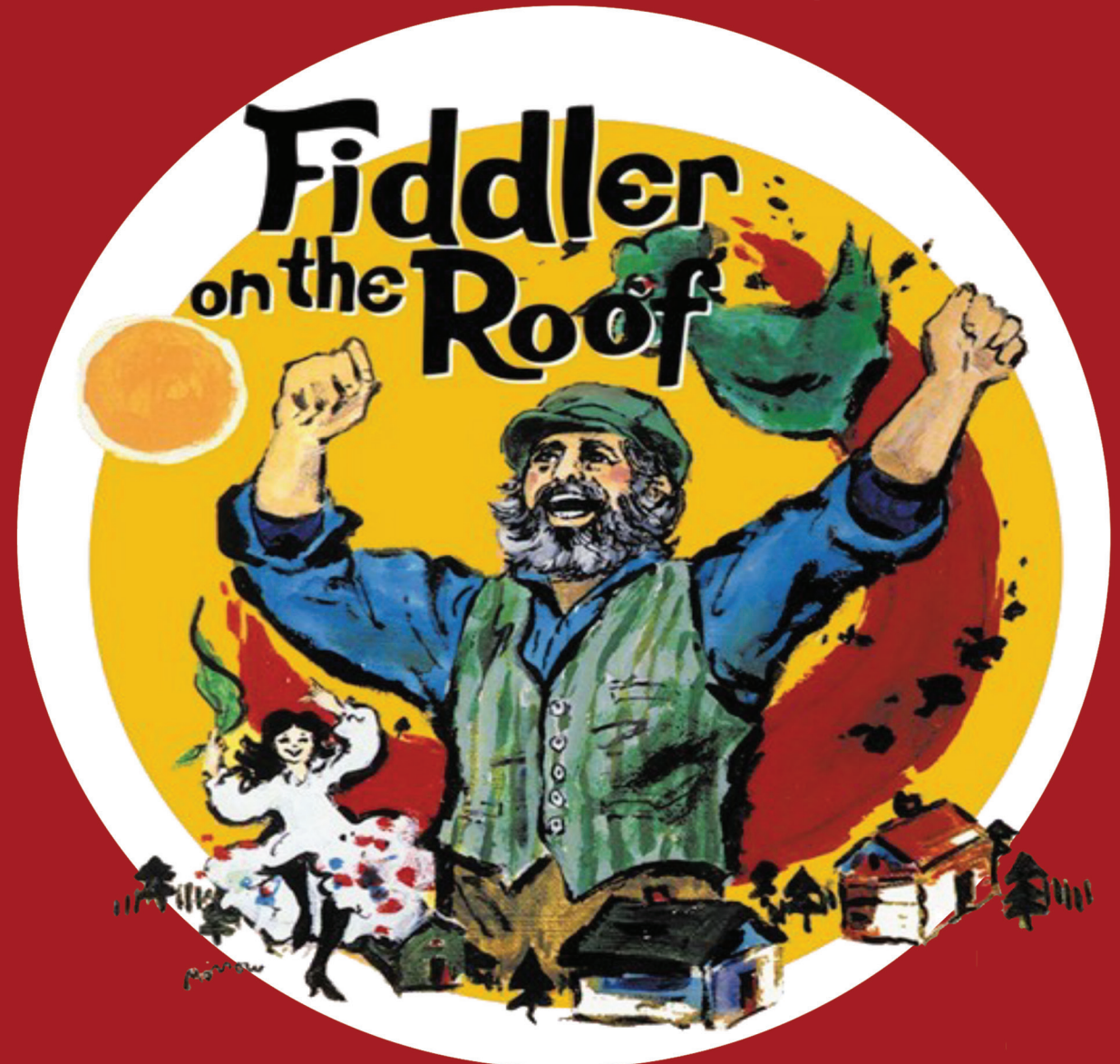
